

## From the Desk of Councilman Mike Madigan

**Candidate for Town Supervisor** 

**Town Council Race:** Please consider an exceptional candidate for the June 27<sup>th</sup> Republican Primary for Town Council:

**Dan Kilmer**: Dan recently retired after 38 years in the military where he served in the Navy, Army, and in the Air National Guard.

In 2002 Dan was elected Councilman in Lewiston and served as Deputy Supervisor. As a Councilman, Dan had a reputation for investigating costs and responsibly reducing spending.

Dan served 12 years on the Board of Directors for the Lewiston Chamber of Commerce. Dan has extensive knowledge as a small business owner. Dan's record confirms he is a fiscally conservative Republican.

**Supervisor Race:** I am a candidate in the **June 27th Republican Primary for Grand Island Town Supervisor**. The following are important considerations:

- > Fully engaged.
  - ✓ I was appointed by the Town Board to be one of the two Board members on the negotiation team for six different Union Contracts over the past five years. **My opponent was on the Town Board for these same 5 years but chose not to engage.**
  - ✓ All other Town Council members have supported conducting the twice-monthly invoice audits. **My opponent never conducted even one of these audits in his past five years.**
- ➤ I have a record of accomplishments including:
  - ✓ Uncovering a major theft of town funds (over \$116,000) that resulted in a prosecution.
  - ✓ Drove to completion a three-pronged town-wide theft preventive action plan.
  - ✓ Initiating the LED Light conversion project that saved over \$50,000 in 2023 and once fully paid will save the town over \$250,000/year.
- ➤ 2018 budget: I stopped Nate McMurray's plan to breach the tax-cap that he claimed was required due to sewer debt it was not required. For the 2023 budget I again pushed to cut spending first and voted against breaching the tax cap my opponent voted instead to breach the tax cap without ever attempting to cut spending first.
- > I self-fund my campaigns. I cannot be bought.
  - ✓ My opponent accepts large donations from <u>developers with business before the Town including \$2000 total from SouthPointe in December 2021.</u>

Our commitment to you: Dan and I are fiscal conservatives who are results driven. We will focus on containing spending/cost reductions long before ever considering breaching the NYS property tax cap.

Voters have a clear choice: Vote for Dan Kilmer for Town Council and Mike Madigan for Town Supervisor on June 27<sup>th</sup>.
