Remembering Barbara "Babs" Davis

We skied in the winter, laughing and falling down a lot, and had great pool parties in the summer that often included her brilliant, but irascible, Abe. Sometimes we just talked for hours over a glass of sherry, well maybe two glasses. Who else would have a whelping box in the middle of their living room...only Babs. It's that kind of friendship that lasts a lifetime. I know all those who knew her will miss her as I do; may she live on in our hearts."
