Regardless of age or health status, everyone 18 years and above should have a health care proxy. Have discussions with your loved ones about your wishes, and if you are a proxy for someone, be sure you are prepared to be their voice. **What is Palliative care? What is Hospice Care?** Do you know where to call if you or a loved one is faced with serious illness? Home Connections and Hospice Buffalo are two programs for families facing such challenges.
