Working in conjunction with a member's primary care provider (PCP), each managed long-term care program coordinates everything members need to stay safe and healthy at home by using a large, wide array of specialty providers in their network. Medicaid pays for these services. We also have our Medicare Advantage Plan which has many benefits for those also on Medicare and Medicaid.


