SKINNY: Shifty sophomore played only five games on varsity, spending the first four weeks on JV. ... Averaged 6.1 yards per carry, gradually becoming the Vikings' featured back. ... Ran for over 125 yards in each of his final three games, including a 31-carry, 168-yard, 2 TD performance in a 23-0 win over McKinley to close the regular season. ... Named second team All-A North.

Offensive Linemen

Joe Gioeli, Grand Island

STATS: 29 tackles, 1.5 sacks, 3 FR, 1 block.

SKINNY: Senior teamed with Nick Paolini and Tommy Doctor to solidify the area's best offensive line. ... Started both ways in the trenches. ... Kept his head up and was opportunistic on defense, leading the Vikings in fumble recoveries.

Nick Paolini, Grand Island

STATS: 30 tackles, 2 TFLs.

SKINNY: First team All-A North helped control the line of scrimmage on both sides of the ball. ... Senior captain whom coach Dean Santorio called, "the hardest worker on our team." ... Helped propel the Vikings to over 1,400 total rushing yards.
