Whereas, a plaque "In appreciation to the people of Grand Island from the Men of the Green Beret" containing the United States Army Special Forces distinctive unit insignia and their motto "De Oppresso Liber" was presented to the Town on June 12, 1970 and displayed on the Court Bench in the Town Hall; and

Whereas, a 45<sup>th</sup> Memorial Reunion of the members of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion, 19<sup>th</sup> Special Forces Group (Airborne) New York Army National Guard is being held at the Niagara Falls Air Force Reserve Base on April 20 and 21, 2013; now therefore
