- ☐ Picture of honoree: Clear photo of honoree in uniform is preferred, no others in photo (we may be able to help locate a photo if needed). Emailed photos need to be scanned as a jpg at 200 dpi resolution or higher. Send to ginyherobanners@gmail.com.
- ☐ Check for \$200 made payable to: Grand Island American Legion Post 1346. Please mail to: Grand Island American Legion, PO BOX 1346 Grand Island, NY 14072. We will process the application when we receive your payment and your application will be placed on the list in the order it was received.
- ☐ Applications must have a copy of separation paper (Form DD-214 or equivalent) AND proof of Grand Island, NY Residency attached at the time of submission. Failure to include either of these items may result in delay of your banner application.
