RiverView Connector Project Page

- Work on the transformation of the West River Parkway will begin on April 16, 2018. The Parkway will close on that day.
- The project is expected to be complete in the Fall of 2018.
- Total project cost is \$2.5 million.
- LIRO Program and Construction Management is the construction manager that will oversee the day to day work on the trail project.
- Anastasi Trucking will be the general contractor who will complete this project.

Area Below Removed

- As of April 10, the West River Trail becomes a formal work zone under the control of our contractor, Anastasi Trucking who is responsible for setting guidelines as to how they will maintain the safety of their employees as well as the general public during construction. To that end, we ask all members of the public to be mindful of the construction by keeping a safe distance from the work zone. Anastasi will be maintaining pedestrian-only access to the water's edge throughout the life of the project (safety-permitting) however, motorized vehicles such as ATV's, UTVs, tractors etc. will be prohibited for safety reasons.
- Throughout the summer, the Department of Transportation will continue to maintain the grass median as they always have. Once the project is complete, State Parks will assume all maintenance duties. Please note that the private mowing of the park's lawns will be prohibited moving forward.
- During the construction, State Parks will focus our efforts on the operational detail of the trail, including maintenance of the eight miles of trails.
