BOCES center receives grant for baseball field upgrades

Playground equipment, a scoreboard and a press box will be built at the Miracle League baseball field on Grand Island, with funding from a national home improvement store chain and the manpower from local students.

The Erie 1 BOCES Kenton Career& Technical Center recently was awarded a \$10,000 grant through the Lowe's Charitable and Educational Foundation. Kenton was only one of four organizations in the state to receive a grant.

This spring, students from the center —which participates in SkillsUSA, a national nonprofit organization working to ensure America has a skilled work force —will begin work at the field in Veterans Park. In addition to the construction, students also will work on landscaping the field, which opened last September to provide a safe baseball environment for children with disabilities.

The baseball complex has a 40-by 100-foot pavilion, as well as a wheelchair- accessible concessions stand and restrooms.
