



# *Is your team Prepared for Relay Night?*

## What to bring...

In order to be best prepared for Relay For Life, it may be helpful if you bring the following items:

- ◆ Money!!
- ◆ Furnishings for your camp site: Tent (pop-up...optional), folding tables, chairs, blankets
- ◆ Family & Friends!!
- ◆ Survivors!!
- ◆ Items to decorate your camp site – don't forget your team banner!
- ◆ Money!!
- ◆ Supplies needed for your on-site fundraiser/carnival game
- ◆ Comfortable walking/running shoes
- ◆ Proper clothing for weather – rain gear, sweatshirts, coats, t-shirts, shorts, umbrella, etc. (event is held rain or shine!)
- ◆ Money!!
- ◆ Insect repellent
- ◆ Sunscreen
- ◆ Flashlights
- ◆ Donations, Luminarias and/or registration fees to turn in
- ◆ Camera & batteries
- ◆ Money!!

**DO NOT** bring the following:

- ◆ Weapons of any kind
- ◆ Cigarettes or tobacco products
- ◆ Alcoholic beverages
- ◆ Grills, barbecues or other items with open flame
- ◆ Rollerblades / skateboards / bikes etc.
- ◆ Please do not bring pets!
