

District installs online payment tool

Members of the Grand Island school community now have an online tool to acquire many of the academic-related items they'll need and want.

The district recently installed an online payment through RevTrac to allow students and residents to pay for review books, school clothes and community education fees. This was done to allow for greater ease in the purchase process, according to Cheryl Chamberlain, a high school business teacher.

A possible expansion of the service could allow for the purchase of yearbooks and Advanced Placement exam fees through the site.

The site is available through the bookstore link on Grand Island High School's page on the district website.

There is a small fee involved, Chamberlain said, that's woven into the posted price of each item on the site.
