1/10	Long Rd.	Fire	Deputies assisted Grand Island Fire Department for a fire inside of an industrial plant. No injuries were reported.
1/10	Blackmon Rd.	Drunk Driving	Following an investigation of a suspicious vehicle, Deputies arrested 23 y/o Veronica Brown for Driving While Intoxicated and a traffic infraction. Brown submitted a sample of her blood for chemical analysis. Brown was then issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and released to the custody of a sober 3 rd party.
