

Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 168 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

1/12	West River Rd.	Animal Bite	Complainant states that she was walking her dog and 2 other dogs attacked hers. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
1/12	Oak Harbor Rd.	Trespass	Complainant states that several subjects were on his property and they did not have permission. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subjects. No damage was observed.

1/14	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Complainant states that a vehicle was parked in a lot of a closed business. Deputies located the vehicle and the

			owner who was conducting repair work to the structure.

1/15	Whitehaven Rd.	Larceny	Complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole license plates from his vehicle.
1/16	East River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that it appeared her handicap vehicle tag was stolen from her vehicle.
1/16	Alvin Rd.	Customer Trouble	Employees at Fucillo Dealer state that several customers were being disruptive and refusing to leave. Deputies located the subjects and advised them. The subjects left without further incident.
1/16	Alt Blvd.	Larceny	Complainant states that a credit card was stolen from a business office at an unknown time.
1/16	Whitehaven Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.

1/16	East River Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Complainant states that a pickup truck was in the Whitehaven Cemetery during the late evening hours. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle. No damage was observed.
1/16	River Oaks Dr.	Road Obstruction	Deputies removed several Christmas trees that had blown into the roadway.
1/16	Love Rd.	Road Obstruction	Deputies located broken glass in the roadway. The glass was removed.
1/17	Grand Island Blvd.	Residential Fire	Deputies assisted the Grand Island Fire Department after receiving a 911 call reporting a house on fire. All occupants were able to escape the residence without injury. Damage was reported as minimal by the Fire Department.
1/17	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Employees of Tops Markets state that 2 vehicles were parked in the lot for approximately an hour and they appeared to be occupied. Deputies located the vehicles and advised the drivers. The subjects left without incident.

1/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
1/18	Bedell Rd.	Fraud	Complainant states that an unknown person(s) used her

			bank card to make purchases in another state.
1/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that a subject entered a store and was asking for directions to the Rehab Center. The subject left shortly after. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject.
1/18	Ransom Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a 911 hang up call at the Grand Island High School. Deputies checked the school and were unable to locate any persons in need of assistance.
1/18	Settlers Row	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that 2 teenage boys pounded on her door and then fled the area on foot. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subjects. No damage was observed.
