1/16	Suspicious Incident	Beaver Island Pkwy	Deputies received a call from a driver having a problem with a female following him around in her vehicle. Deputies were able to stop the female driver and speak with her. She was advised and issued traffic citations for some lighting issues on her vehicle.
1/18	Disturbance Other	Alt Bd.	Deputies responded to a residence for an unwelcome guest disturbance. The son-in-law showed up without permission trying to start an argument with his soon to be ex-wife. Parents own home and they want him arrested. Subject was located and arrested back at his residence. Subject was taken to the ECHC pending arraignment and an order of protection was requested.
1/21	Suspicious Incident	Independence Ln	Deputies responded to a homeowner calling because his garage was open when he got home. He said he closed it when he left. Deputies checked the garage and homeowner believes some things were moved around such as the ski boots but nothing appears missing. Homeowner is going to investigate further and advise patrol.
1/21	Traffic Stop/ Warrant Arrest	I-190 @ Whitehaven Rd.	Deputies initiated a traffic stop on a red Volkswagen sedan for a light out. After speaking with the driver, she was found to have a suspended license and an active arrest warrant out of the Town of Hamburg. Subject was arrested, processed, and transported to ECMC for a MHL 9.41 evaluation after making threats to patrol.
