

Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 179 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **<u>Grand Island</u>**.

			money for her safe return. Initially the complainant was
			unable to get a hold of his wife and became worried.
			Deputies advised the complainant the call was most
			likely a scam.
1/23	Baseline Rd.	Accident Injury	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle
			accident. 2 occupants complained of general pain but
			refused treatment from first aid personnel.
