The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 144 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
1/18	Blackmon Rd.	Residential Fire	Deputies assisted the Grand Island Fire Department for a report of an oven fire.
1/18	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a suspicious vehicle was parked in Veterans Park near a maintenance building during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the vehicle and spoke to the occupants. The subjects had been using the headlights to light up a late evening hockey game and the battery died.
1/19	Baseline Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.

The subject was collecting discarded cigarettes for his own personal use. The subject was advised and left without incident.

Narcotics Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 27 y/o Ashley Tiedemann for Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7 th Degree (Class A Misdemeanor) and several traffic infractions. Tiedemann was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.

1/22	Alt Blvd.	Pistol Permit Investigation	Deputies conducted a background investigation of a subject who applied for a pistol permit.
1/22	East River Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole a lawn ornament from his yard.

The complainant was concerned due to the frigid temperatures and stopped to give the subject a pair of gloves but still wanted Patrol to check. Deputies located the subject and assisted him to his destination.
