			registered a .16% B.A.C. after submitting a sample of his breathe for Chemical Analysis. Carpenter was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending his arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.

1/25	West River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant stated that several male subjects came to her door and stated they were there to make repairs to her residence. The complainant did not schedule any repairs. Deputies located the subjects who had mistakenly gone to the wrong house.
