



Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

Dates: 12/26/2022 to 01/01/2022

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 215 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

Date	Type	Street	Narrative
12/26	Disturbance/Other	Cinderella Motel	Deputies received a call from a female saying a vehicle is blocking her parking spot. Deputies checked on the vehicle as a courtesy and attempted contact but the vehicle owner was not around. After deputies left both parties got into a verbal argument with each other because the police came. Deputies returned and all parties were advised.
12/27	Mental	Riverdale Dr.	Deputies were called for a boyfriend having a mental breakdown and chasing her with a golf club. State Police responded and spoke with the subject. The male wished to go to hospital for evaluation and was transported by the officer.
12/28	Disturbance	Riverdale Dr.	Deputies responded to a call from a tow company trying to repo a vehicle and males are arguing with him. Deputies spoke with all parties and the vehicle was already secured on the tow truck. Advised to take it up with their bank.
12/29	Suspicious Incident	Grand Island Storage	Deputies received a call from the storage facility involving the fence being cut and locks off of storage units. It appears that an unknown person burglarized 30 units on 12/22/22. Detectives are investigating further.
1/1	DWI/Alcohol	Wendy's	Deputies initiated a traffic stop on a gray RAM pickup in the Wendy's lot. The was found to be intoxicated. He was arrested for a BAC of .11, processed and released to his wife.
1/1	Burglary	Baseline Rd.	Deputies were notified by homeowner that he just noticed that his long guns were stolen from his gun cabinet. Could have occurred any time from the middle of November to now. Report was completed and photos were gathered to turn over to detectives.
