The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 150 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

12/28	West River Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call. Deputies spoke with the occupants and determined the call to be a misdial.
12/28	Grand Island Blvd.	Customer Trouble	Employees of Tops state that a female subject was causing a disturbance in the store. The female left prior to the arrival of Patrol. Deputies located the female nearby and advised her.
