

## **Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary**

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 248 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

10/8	Domestic Trouble	Webb Rd.	Deputies responded to a violent disturbance in progress. Complainant reported that a former dating partner was attempting to break into the home and that the complainant has a shotgun. The offending party did make entry into the home and did take possession of the shotgun. Patrol arrived and deployed a taser to disarm the subject and place the subject in custody. The subject was cleared medically, charged and transported to the Holding Center pending arraignment.		
10/8	DWI/ Alcohol	Grand Island Bd.	Deputies received a report from a complainant that reported that a vehicle just struck their parked car. Deputies located the striking vehicle and noted signs of alcohol impairment displayed by the driver. Driver performed Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and was charged with DWI. The driver refused to submit to a chemical test. The driver was processed and released to a sober third party. The vehicle was placed under a twelve-hour hold.		
10/9	Suicide Attempt	Grand Island Bd.	Deputies received a report of a subject ingesting pills. Upon arrival the subject was conscious and alert but was not responding to Deputies and Narcan had to be administered. Subject was transported to ECMC for treatment and evaluation.		
10/10	Suicide Attempt	Fix Rd.	Mental health counselor called patrol stating that a subject told them he took 10 "benzos". Deputies arrived and found the subject and the subject's spouse who confirmed that the subject took the medication.
