The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 160 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
10/12	Alvin Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Deputies located a vehicle parked in the lot of Fucillo Chevrolet during the early hours of the morning. The driver of the vehicle was located and advised.
10/12	Riverdale Dr.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime in recent days an unknown person(s) stole the outdrive from his watercraft. Investigation Ongoing.
10/12	Love Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that numerous racial slurs were written in chalk on various items around the playground at Kaegabine Elementary School. The chalk was removed.
10/12	Grand Island Blvd.	Customer Trouble	An employee of Chateau Motor Lodge states that a customer was violating the room agreement and refused to leave the premise. After speaking with Patrol, the subject was refunded the money he paid for his room and left the premise without further incident.
10/12	Beaver Island State Park	Animal Complaint	The complainant states that a dog was in the water near the docks at Beaver Island State Park and could not get out of the water. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
10/12	Stony Point Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was sleeping on the lawn of a residence in the neighborhood. Deputies located the subject who owned the property and advised him.
10/12	Staley Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
10/12	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that several subjects were walking in the roadway and the complainant almost struck them. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any persons in the road.
10/12	Laurie La.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime in recent hours an unknown person(s) stole 2 bicycles from an open garage. The bicycles were found several days later, left abandoned in a nearby neighborhood.
10/13	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	An employee of a local auto mechanic shop stated that an unknown person(s) was stealing scrap metal from his yard and when approached by employees the subjects

			fled the scene in a U-Haul. An employee followed the U-Haul into Niagara County where the subject exited the U-haul and fled on foot. A check confirmed the U-Haul was reported stolen during prior days. Investigation Ongoing.
10/13	Stony Point Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
10/14	White Oak La.	Accident Hit & Run	The complainant states he awoke to the sound of a vehicle crash outside his residence. When he looked outside he noticed a vehicle leaving the scene after it struck the complainant's vehicle. Deputies were able to locate the suspect vehicle by a plate that was left behind. The driver of the vehicle was issued several traffic tickets returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
10/14	Grand Island Blvd.	Parking Complaint	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked unlawfully in the handicap parking space at Tops. Deputies located the driver of the vehicle who had forgotten to display her Handicap parking tag.
10/14	East River Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a suspicious vehicle was parked across the street from his residence and appeared to be occupied. Deputies located the vehicle and advised the driver.
10/15	Bedell Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
10/15	Colonial Dr.	Pistol Permit Investigation	Deputies conducted a background check for a subject who applied for a pistol permit.
10/15	Ransom Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked at the corner of his street for a few hours and appeared to be occupied. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any vehicle matching the description given.
10/15	Long Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that 2 youths were riding their bicycles around the Dunlop Building. Deputies located the youths and advised them.

10/17	Deerwood La.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states she had recently arrived home and kept hearing noises inside the house. Deputies checked the residence and determined the complainant to be unfounded.
10/17	Bedell Rd.	Loud Music	The complainant states that loud music was coming from a nearby apartment in his building. Deputies checked and determined the complaint to be unfounded.
10/18	East Park Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.

10/18	N Colony Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
10/18	Baseline Rd.	Customer Trouble	An employee of a cab company stated that his fare was giving him a hard time and refusing to pay the fee. After speaking with Deputies, the customer paid the cab fee and left without further incident.
10/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 45 y/o Randy Gleave of Grand Island after a DMV check showed Gleave's license was currently revoked. Gleave was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
10/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that an intoxicated male was wondering around the area of the Grand Island Plaza. Deputies located the subject and assisted him to his residence.
