10/13	Burglary - Residence	Baseline Rd.	Deputies responded to a reported burglary from a residence. The complainant reported that they do not lock the residence. Deputies completed an initial investigation and completed a police report. Detectives were notified for continued investigation.
10/14	Accident Hit and Run	Enola Rd.	Deputies received a report of a vehicle striking a parked car and leaving the scene. Deputies received another report around the corner of the first incident of a loud noise and a damaged vehicle parked on the road. Deputies found the vehicle and contacted the owner. Deputies confirmed that the vehicle owner was not the driver. Deputies developed a suspect. Deputies towed the vehicle and completed an accident report. Investigation continues.

A vehicle was left behind in the driveway by the subjects and was found to have been reported stolen out of Buffalo a few hours prior. The complainant's vehicle was quickly located on Baseline and Staley Rd. unoccupied. Both vehicles were towed and processed for further investigation.
