The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 227 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

10/19	Domestic Trouble	Baseline Rd.	Deputies received a complaint from a female who believes her boyfriend took her TV's. Female explained that she just came home to find her 3 TV's missing. Only person who had access was her boyfriend whom she is having problems with. Deputies are investigating further.
10/19	Runaway	Warner Dr.	Deputies responded to a residence on Warner Dr. for a juvenile who jumped out the window and ran away from the home.  When deputies arrived the child had already returned home and all parties were spoken to and all was calm.
10/19	Traffic Stop/ Arrest	Baseline Rd.	State Police initiated a traffic stop of a red Dodge pickup on Baseline Rd. During the stop the drive refused to cooperate and fought with the trooper. The subject had to be pepper sprayed and wrestled to the ground by the trooper and the help of deputies. The subject was arrested, processed at the State Police barracks, and arraigned in Grand Island Court.
10/20	Rescue	East River Rd.	Deputies responded to a male stuck in an elevator in his home. Grand Island PD was able to release the emergency lock to the door and get the elderly male out. Elevator seems to be stuck, advised to notify installer.
10/21	Shoplifting	7-11	Deputies responded to a shoplifting complaint at 7-11. A teenage male took an 18 pack of Labatt's beer without paying. Clerk believes she knows the subject and gave deputies his name. Deputies are investigating further.
10/22	Mental	Riverdale Dr.	Deputies responded to a neighbor's address for a female who was there after arguing with her husband. Deputies spoke with all parties and determined that the female needed to be transported to ECMC on MHL 9.41 for evaluation.
