The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 144 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
10/17	Bedell Rd.	Drunk Driving	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 48 y/o Peter Beyer of Grand Island for Driving While Intoxicated and other traffic infractions. Beyer refused to submit a sample of his breath for chemical analysis. Beyer was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and released to the custody of a sober 3 rd party.
10/17	Regency Dr.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked in her driveway and one of the subjects exited and began to ring her doorbell and knock on her door. Deputies located the subject who was attempting to serve legal papers at the residence.
10/17	Whitehaven Rd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a blue colored older Chevrolet with a loud muffler was driving on the shoulder of the road. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.
10/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) damaged some political signs on her lawn.
10/18	Center Terr.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident in the parking lot of the Town Hall Terrace Apartment complex. No injuries were reported.
10/18	Staley Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked in the lot of the vacant radio station and a door to the building was open. Deputies checked and determined no subjects made entry into the building. The occupants of the vehicle were located nearby and advised.
10/18	Foxcroft St.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime in the past day, an unknown person(s) stole several political signs from his front lawn.
10/19	Long Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 37 y/o Daniel Harding of Grand Island for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Harding was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.

10/19	West Oakfield Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states that a truck was parked in her driveway that she did not recognize and the driver got out and was knocking on her door. Deputies located the male subject and determined he was a contractor hired by NYSEG to trim trees in the area.
10/19	Ward Park Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime in recent weeks an unknown person(s) stole various items from his garage.
10/19	Bedell Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime during the day an unknown person(s) stole his satellite dish from the yard of apartment complex.
10/19	Stony Point Rd.	Shots Fired	Numerous complainants state they heard 2 or 3 shots fired in the area. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the source of the shots. No other shots fired were heard.
10/19	Ransom Rd.	ATV Injury Accident	Deputies responded to a report of an ATV accident where the driver was pinned by a barn door. Deputies were able to remove the barn door from the driver who was then transported by Mercy Flight to a nearby hospital with serious injuries.
10/20	Baseline Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call at a residence. Deputies made contact with the occupant and determined the call was a misdial.
10/20	Tracey La.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that sometime during the day, an unknown person(s) smashed his pumpkin in the driveway.
10/20	Whitehaven Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states that a dog escaped from the Grand Island Small Animal Hospital and was running loose in the area. The Dog Control Officer was notified. The dog was found later in the evening by a passerby who returned the animal to the hospital.
10/23	Ransom Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Employees of Grand Island High School state they found a live round of small caliber ammunition in a classroom. It was determined by staff that no credible threat was imminent and the item was turned over to Patrol.
10/23	Lang Blvd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call at a local business. Deputies checked and determined the call was a misdial.
10/23	Tracey La.	Identity Theft	The complainant states that an unknown person(s) attempted to open a credit card in his name without his authorization.
10/23	Grand Island Blvd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a vehicle left M&T Bank and the driver appeared to be intoxicated. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
10/23	Ransom Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a mailbox. No injuries were reported.
10/23	Stony Point Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that she heard people in her backyard during the late evening hours. Deputies checked but found no persons or signs of disturbance in the yard.
10/23	Lakeview Te.	Noise Complaint	The complainant states that the sound of a TV was too loud in a nearby apartment in his complex during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked and determined the

			complaint was unfounded.
10/23	Ferry Rd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states she could hear cars racing up and down the street. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any vehicles racing.
