



## Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

Dates: 9/22/2012 to 9/28/2012

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 147 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

9/22	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Person	Employees at Noco state that a suspicious male subject was loitering behind the business. Deputies located the subject and advised him. The subject left without incident.

Parisi was charged with 3 counts of Grand Larceny 4 <sup>th</sup> Degree (Class E Felony), Tampering with Physical Evidence (Class E Felony), Criminal Mischief 3 <sup>rd</sup> Degree (Class E Felony), Conspiracy 5 <sup>th</sup> Degree (Class A Misdemeanor) and Obstruction of Governmental Administration 2 <sup>nd</sup> Degree (Class A Misdemeanor). Morris was charged with 3 counts of Grand Larceny 4 <sup>th</sup> Degree, and Conspiracy 5 <sup>th</sup> Degree. Additionally Morris was found to have a valid Bench Warrant issued from Grand Island Court. Both subjects were transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending their arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.
