



Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 149 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
10/20	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Incident	Deputies observed a few lights on inside of Fantasy Island that are not usually activated. Deputies were able to contact a night security guard who was patrolling the park.
10/20	Grand Island Blvd.	Burglary	Complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) entered his business and stole various items from inside. Investigation Ongoing.
10/20	Grand Island Blvd.	Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle	Complainant states that he left his vehicle at an auto repair shop with keys inside. When he returned to the business the vehicle was missing. The vehicle was recovered several days later in the City of Buffalo. Investigation Ongoing.
10/20	Ward Park Rd.	Harassment	Complainant states she received a call from a blocked number, and the person on the other end made harassing statements.
10/20	Broadway	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a vehicle was weaving in and out of traffic. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.
10/20	Marlin Dr.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that 2 suspicious persons were on his property and began knocking on the door. The complainant stated he thought he saw one subject with a gun. Deputies were able to determine the incident to be a miscommunication between family members. The subjects were friends who were picking up toy guns for a Halloween Party.
10/20	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Deputies located a suspicious vehicle parked behind a closed business during the late hours of the night. Deputies spoke to the owner who was renovating the building.
10/21	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Deputies located a suspicious vehicle that was unoccupied in a parking lot of a closed business. Deputies contacted the owner who was selling the vehicle.
10/21	Industrial Dr.	Suspicious Vehicle	Deputies located a suspicious vehicle that was unoccupied in a parking lot of a closed business. Deputies further found the door to the business to be open. Deputies searched the property but determined the incident to be an oversight by employees.

10/21	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	Complainant states that a former employee of Sunoco had stolen an undetermined amount of money from the store. Investigation Ongoing.
10/21	Grand Island Blvd.	Road Obstruction	Complainant states that a large piece of wood was in the roadway obstructing traffic. Deputies checked but were unable to locate any obstructions.
10/22	East River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states a strong smell of natural gas was in the area. Deputies and Grand Island Fire checked but were unable to determine any source of leaking natural gas.
10/22	East River Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	Complainant states that sometime in recent days an unknown vehicle struck a guardrail and damaged it. NITTEC was notified to fix the guardrail.
10/22	West River Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call. Deputies were able to speak to the homeowner and determined the call to be a misdial.
10/22	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant stated that video surveillance footage showed a suspicious male walking through his business lot during the night. At the time of the report, nothing was reporting missing.
10/22	Stony Point Rd.	Pistol Permit Investigation	Deputies conducted a background check of an individual who applied for a pistol permit.
10/22	Sunset Dr.	Loud Music	Complainant states that loud music was coming from a Halloween display in the neighborhood during the late evening hours. Deputies located the residence in question and advised the owner.
10/23	Baseline Rd.	Accident Injury	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident with injuries. 1 Driver was treated on scene by Grand Island Fire Department for minor back pain.
10/23	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	Employees at Tops state that a vehicle drove off without paying for gasoline. Investigation Ongoing.
10/23	Broadway	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a vehicle was all over the roadway. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.
10/23	South State Pkwy	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
10/23	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Complainant states that a suspicious vehicle kept driving around her apartment building. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.

Deputies investigation led to the arrest of a Juvenile Offender for Unlawful Possession of Marijuana. The Juvenile Offender was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
10/23	Bedell Rd.	Loud Music	Complainant states that loud music was coming from another apartment in his complex. Deputies located a loud television in the complex and advised the occupant.
10/24	Grand Island Blvd.	Burglary	Employees state that sometime during the night, an unknown person entered their business through a window and stole an undetermined amount of cash and various items.
10/24	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states a suspicious male was giving

			customers a hard time at Laundry Lounge. The subject left prior to the arrival of patrol.
10/24	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
10/24	Whitehaven Rd.	Road Obstruction	Complainant states that a large amount of debris was in the roadway obstructing traffic. Deputies located the debris and removed it from the roadway.
10/25	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Complainant states that a suspicious vehicle was parked in Holiday Inn parking lot and running with no one around it. Deputies located the vehicle which had heavy damage to the front end. Deputies later identified the driver who was involved in a hit & run property damage accident. The driver was issued several traffic tickets.
10/25	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that a suspicious person was wandering around the Laundry Lounge on Grand Island Blvd. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject.
10/25	Whitehaven Rd.	Larceny	Employees of Ace Hardware state that a subject came into the store and stole various tools. Investigation Ongoing.
10/25	South State Pkwy.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
10/25	Staley Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	Complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown vehicle struck a few mailboxes in the area.
10/25	South State Pkwy.	Animal Loose	Complainant states a large dog was running loose in the area. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
10/25	Baseline Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
10/25	East River Rd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that a suspicious male was knocking on her door numerous times. Deputies located the subject and advised him.
10/26	Riverdale Dr.	Animal Loose	Complainant states that a dog was running loose through the neighborhood. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
10/26	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Complainant states that a suspicious vehicle was driving very slowly and pulling in and out of multiple driveways. Deputies located the vehicle which was delivering newspapers.
10/26	Colonial Dr. West	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a vehicle had struck his neighbor's house. The suspect vehicle then fled down Driftwood. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle. Minor damage was done to the residence.

10/26	South State Pkwy	Deer Struck	Complainant states a deer had been struck by a vehicle and was lying in the roadway. Deputies removed the deer from the roadway and notified NITTEC.

10/26	Baseline Rd.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a vehicle was driving erratically on the roadway. Deputies located the vehicle and advised the driver.

10/26	Love Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Complainant states that a vehicle was parked behind 711 with no one inside. Deputies located the vehicle but were unable to make contact with the owner.
10/26	Blue Jay La.	Youth Activity	Complainant states that a group of youths were running through the neighborhood throwing items at residences. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the youths. No damage was reported.
