

Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 228 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

Date	Type	Street	Narrative
10/31	Suspicious Incident	Speedway	Deputies received a call from Speedway that a male and female were trying to break into the ATM out front. Deputies located the subjects and the white Dodge Ram. The witness who told staff about it was gone and we didn't have their name. The ATM was definitely tampered with but the subject's denied any involvement. They were released by patrol and advised.
11/1	Threat	Ransom Rd.	Deputies were contacted in regards to an 8 year old student who claimed that another student had a written hit list and that supposedly their name was on it. The detective task force responded to Grand Island and interviewed everyone involved as well as the school. The threat was deemed not to be credible. School will handle further investigation on their end.
11/1	Neighbor Dispute / Warrant Arrest	Whitewater Way	Deputies received a call from resident at the complex that another neighbor was harassing him. Deputies spoke with both parties and during the interview the subject was found to have an active warrant out of Kenmore. He was detained and turned over to Kenmore PD. All parties advised.
11/3	Accident - Injury	Baseline Rd.	Deputies responded to an accident involving a car and a riding lawn mower. Neighbor was backing out of driveway and foot slipped off brake onto gas. She drove backward into neighbor's yard across the street and struck the neighbor while he was cutting his lawn. Male was thrown from his John Deere mower and suffered several injuries. Male was transported to ECMC by ambulance and deputies did an accident report.
11/6	Traffic Complaint	Bedell Rd.	Deputies received an anonymous call from a male on Bedell Rd. saying a red Dodge just went by at around 130mph and is now sitting next to his burn out patch on Bedell Rd. Deputies located the red Charger and spoke with the driver and owner. They were advised.
11/6	Disturbance Other	Budget Motel	Deputies responded to the motel for a female who keyed another female's car and they are now arguing. Deputies spoke with a female who had damage to her vehicle but did not wish any charges. Other half left the scene before patrols arrival. All parties were advised on how to proceed in the future.
