The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 149 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

| 11/1 | Grand Island Blvd. | Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle | The complainant states that sometime in recent hours an unknown person(s) stole his vehicle while it was parked in the TC's Lounge parking lot. Deputies located the vehicle on the premise. |
| 11/1 | Carl Rd. | Suspicious Vehicle | The complainant states that a suspicious vehicle was parked on Carl Rd. Deputies located the vehicle and made contact with the registered owner who had just moved to the area. |
| 11/2 | Bedell Rd. | Accident PDO | Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident in the parking lot of Country Glen Apartments. No injuries were reported. |
| 11/2 | Bedell Rd. | Suspicious Person | The complainant states she observed a male subject in Veterans Park wearing a ski mask. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the male by the description given. |
| 11/2 | Bedell Rd. | Vehicle Fire | Deputies assisted Grand Island Fire Department with a report of a vehicle fire. |
| 11/2 | Stony Point Rd. | Reckless Operation | The complainant states that a vehicle was swerving all over the roadway. Deputies located the vehicle which was unoccupied at the registered owners address. |
| 11/3 | Broadway | Accident Injury | Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident with rollover. 2 occupants were taken to local hospitals with seemingly non-life threatening injuries. |
| 11/3 | Whitehaven Rd. | Larceny | The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole various items from his unlocked vehicle. |
| 11/3 | Fix Rd. | ATV Operation | The complainant states that an ATV was operating up and down the street. Deputies located the operator and advised him. |
| 11/3 | Colonial Dr. East | Criminal Mischief | The complainant states that sometime in the past week, an unknown person(s) damaged her coat while she was at a party. |
| 11/3 | Grand Island Blvd. | Fraud | The manager of Tim Hortons states that a subject schemed the business out of money after performing a short change scheme on an employee. The subject then |

| 11/3 | Grand Island Blvd. | Accident PDO | Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident in the parking lot of Mighty Taco. No injuries were reported. |
| 11/3 | Baseline Rd. | Suspicious Person | The complainant states that a male subject was lurking around in the bushes of his apartment complex. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any suspicious subjects. |
| 11/4 | Pleasant Trail | Welfare Check | Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call. Deputies determined the call to be a problem with the phone lines. |
| 11/4 | Love Rd. | Larceny | The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole various items from his unlocked vehicle. |
| 11/4 | Stony Point Rd. | Accident Injury | Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. 1 passenger was taken to a local hospital with seemingly non-life threatening injuries. |
| 11/4 | The Commons | Suspicious Person | The complainant states that a male subject in a hoody was standing on her porch when she arrived home. When the male subject saw the complainant he ran into the woods. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject by the description given. Nothing was reported damaged or stolen. |
| 11/4 | Ransom Rd. | Larceny | The complainant states that while she was at Grand Island High School, an unknown person(s) stole headphones from a locker on the premise. |
| 11/4 | West River Pkwy. | Deer Struck | Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported. |
| 11/4 | Marlin Ct. | Welfare Check | Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call. Deputies spoke with the occupants and determined the call to be a misdial. |
| 11/5 | Bedell Rd. | Disorderly Person | Deputies responded to a report of an intoxicated male subject who was yelling obscenities in the apartment complex of Country Glen. Their investigation led to the arrest of 49 y/o Timothy Mosgrove of Grand Island for Disorderly Conduct (Violation). Mosgrove was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court. |
| 11/6 | Second St. | Barking Dog | The complainant states that a dog was barking for several hours somewhere in the neighborhood. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any barking dogs. |
| 11/6 | West Park Rd. | Suspicious Person | The complainant states that 4 subjects were walking down the street drinking beer. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subjects by the description given. |
| 11/6 | East River Rd. | Suspicious Person | The complainant states that a suspicious person was walking near the base of the South Grand Island Bridge. Deputies located the male subject who was taking pictures of the bridge. |

| 11/6 | Sheree Dr. | Animal Loose | The complainant states that 2 dogs were running loose through the neighborhood. The Dog Control Officer was notified. |
| 11/6 | Love Rd. | Reckless Operation | The complainant states that a vehicle was driving all over the roadway. Deputies located the vehicle, unoccupied at the registered owners address. |
| 11/6 | Baseline Rd. | Accident PDO | Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported. |
| 11/6 | Park La. | Suspicious Incident | The complainant states that she heard talking and a cell phone ringing just outside the window of her residence during the late evening hours. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any persons. |
| 11/7 | Amy Dr. | Customer Trouble | A cab driver stated that a male subject had left the cab without paying the fare during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject. |
| 11/7 | Amy Dr. | Warrant Arrest / Traffic Arrest | While investigating the above complaint, it was determined the cab driver who had originally called 911 had an outstanding warrant from the City of Buffalo. Deputies arrested 41 y/o Jimmie Workman of Buffalo. Workman was also charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Workman was transferred to the custody of the Buffalo Police Department. |
| 11/7 | Love Rd. | Open Window | Deputies responded to a burglary alarm at Kaegabine Elementary School. While checking the premise, Deputies observed several open windows. A search of the building was conducted but no persons were found inside. The open windows were determined to be an oversight. |
| 11/7 | Broadway | Animal Complaint | The complainant states that a dog was barking for several minutes during the early morning hours. Deputies located the barking dog but were unable to make contact with the owner. |
| 11/7 | Autumnwood Dr. | Suspicious Person | The complainant states that a suspicious male subject was walking through the yards in the neighborhood. Deputies determined that the subject lived nearby but were unable to make contact with him. |
| 11/7 | Grand Island Blvd. | Accident PDO | Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported. |
| 11/7 | East River Rd. | Road Obstruction | Deputies removed a garbage tote from the roadway that was causing a traffic hazard. |
| 11/7 | Bedell Rd. | Wires Down | Deputies responded to a report of a bus that had struck some wires causing them to fall into the roadway. Time Warner Cable was notified. |
| 11/7 | Town Hall Terr. | Suspicious Incident | The complainant states she observed a male subject dragging a safe to a dumpster in the Town Hall Terrace parking lot. Deputies located the male subject and determined he was the owner of the safe and was disposing of the item. |
