The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 247 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

Date	Type	Street	Narrative
11/7	Larceny	Speedway	Deputies received a call from Speedway that an employee is suspected of stealing lottery tickets. Deputies and detectives are reviewing the evidence for further investigation of charges.
11/8	Traffic Stop/Arrest	I-190@Whitehaven Rd.	Deputies initiated a traffic stop on a black Chrysler sedan for suspended registration. The driver was found to have a suspended license. He was arrested and issued tickets for the charges.
11/9	Runaway	Warner Dr.	Deputies received a call from a distraught mother saying her 16 year old son won't come home. Deputies were informed that it's past his curfew and he's texting her currently. Deputies checked a few areas near home for the male. Eventually he returned home and everything was worked out. All parties advised.
11/12	Natural Death	Long Rd.	Deputies responded to an unresponsive male called in by the family, they believe their father has passed. Deputies arrived and confirmed that the male had passed overnight in his sleep. Family is handling arrangements.
11/12	Traffic Infraction	I-190 @ E River Rd.	Deputies initiated a traffic stop on a white Dodge Ram at a high rate of speed. Deputies attempted to catch vehicle but vehicle refused to stop and the stop was terminated. Deputies have the plate and will investigate the incident further for possible charges.
11/13	Disturbance Other	Crescent Rd	Deputies responded to disturbance between neighbors. One neighbor came to the other neighbor's house to complain about playing drums after midnight. Deputies advised both parties of the noise ordinance and sent them both to their residences.
