The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 156 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
11/7	Orchard Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a male subject was going door to door and asked her to see her utility bill. Deputies located the subject nearby and determined he had a permit from the town permitting him solicit for lower energy bills.
11/7	I-190	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 45 y/o Lisa Savage of Grand Island for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed her license was currently suspended. Savage was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
11/7	East River Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime in the last week, an unknown person(s) stole a motorcycle from his garage.
11/7	Stony Point Rd.	Noise Complaint	The complainant states that a neighbor was playing loud music from his garage all day long. Deputies located the source of the music and advised the occupants.
11/7	Schutt Ct.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a male subject came to her door trying to sell her something. Deputies located the male nearby and confirmed he was an employee of National Fuel.
11/7	Grand Island Blvd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
11/8	Whitehaven Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 35 y/o David Lombardo of Buffalo for Operating a Motor Vehicle with a Suspended Registration (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his registration was currently suspended. Lombardo was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
11/8	Harvey Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states a vehicle was parked off the roadway under the power lines. Deputies located the vehicle and determined the driver got the vehicle stuck.
11/9	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that during the late hours of the night he heard glass break and looked out of his window

			to see a dark colored SUV driving slowly through the neighborhood before leaving. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given and also did not locate any broken glass.
11/9	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
11/9	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject in his 20's was sitting against a utility pole with no shoes on. Deputies located the subject and advised him.
11/9	South State Pkwy.	Animal Complaint	The complainant states that a coyote was standing in the middle of the road. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the animal.
11/10	Sandy Beach Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject came to her door claiming to be from the power company. Deputies located the male subject nearby and determined he had all the proper paperwork to be soliciting door to door.
11/10	East Park Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime in recent weeks an unknown person(s) stole a bicycle from his property.
11/12	Staley Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
11/12	South State Pkwy.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
11/12	Baseline Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a 911 hang up call at a local residence. Deputies spoke with the occupant and determined the call was a misdial.
11/12	Bedell Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that sometime in recent days, an unknown person(s) cut the winterizing sheeting on the bathrooms at Veterans Park.
11/13	Whitehaven Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
11/13	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	The complainant states that he believed one of his employees was stealing from his business (The Bottle Junction). Deputies investigation led to the arrest of 35 y/o Richard Princess of Grand Island for Petit Larceny (Class A Misdemeanor) after he was observed on surveillance video removing cash from the register. Princess was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
11/13	Baseline Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 47 y/o Stephanie Weigel of Grand Island for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed her license was currently suspended. Weigel was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
11/13	Bedell Rd.	Drunk Driving	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 40 y/o Jennifer Langworthy of Grand Island for Driving While Intoxicated and other traffic infractions. Langworthy refused to submit a sample of her breath for chemical analysis. Langworthy was transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$250 bail.
