11/15	Mental	Love Rd.	Deputies received a call from a female stating her boyfriend needs help from crisis services. Deputies responded and spoke with the subject. Crisis services was available to respond and spoke with the subject. It was determined that he needed to go to ECMC sand he was transported by Twin City ambulance.

They fought on the way home from the bar and it got heated when they got home. One subject agreed to go to hotel for the night to diffuse the situation. Police report on file.	
11/20	Unwelcome Guest	Blackmon Rd.	Deputies went to check on a female honking her horn nonstop in driveway. Vehicle was gone when patrol arrived.
