The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 256 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

Date	Type	Street	Narrative
11/22	Disorderly Person	Holiday Inn Express	Deputies received a call from the hotel in regards to an intoxicated male being obnoxious. Deputies spoke with the subject and he was escorted to his room without incident.
11/23	Disorderly Person	Holiday Inn Express	Deputies were called back to the hotel after midnight for the same male knocking on doors and urinating in the elevator. They want him removed from the premises. Deputies took subject to his residence and dropped him off.
11/23	Disorderly Person	Dollar General	Deputies received a call from the manager at the Dollar General who says a known female squirted perfume in her face at the register. Deputies spoke with both parties and the subject was advised that she is not welcome at the store going forward.
11/24	Accident Hit & Run/ DWI Alcohol	Orchard Rd.	Deputies responded to a hit and run accident on Orchard Rd. A few minutes later deputies located the striking vehicle on Ferry Rd. @ South State Pkwy. The driver was evaluated and failed field sobriety tests. He was arrested for DWI, processed registering a .12 BAC, issued an appearance ticket, and released by patrol. Accident report was completed for all the damaged property and vehicles.
11/25	Missing Elderly Person	Gregory Place.	Deputies responded to a missing elderly female. According to husband she suffers from Alzheimer's and went for her usual walk but hasn't come back in about two hours. Patrol's checked the area and the park with negative results. Additional personnel were called to assist with a possible Silver Alert search. Grand Island Fire personnel came across the female walking in the back lot of the Huth Road Elementary School. Subject was evaluated and in good health, she was picked up by her husband.
11/27	Accident/PDO results in a DWI/Alcohol	Stonypoint Rd. @ Whitehaven Rd.	Deputies responded to an accident at the intersection. After speaking with the parties involved one of the driver's was found to be intoxicated. He was detained and transported to the station for processing, where he refused to take a breathalyzer test. Subject was processed and released to his girlfriend.
