The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 167 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
12/5	Lang Blvd.	Suspicious Incident	Deputies located a damaged door of a closed business during the late hours of the night. Deputies spoke with the owner of the business and determined the damage was old.
12/5	Grand Island Blvd.	Warrant Arrest	Following an investigation of an unrelated complaint, Deputies arrested 34 y/o Stephanie Reynolds of Grand Island after a check showed she had an outstanding warrant from the Erie County Sheriff's Office. Reynolds was transported to the Erie County Holding Center.
12/5	Foxcroft St.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that there was a lot of activity at a neighboring house and he believed the owners were out of town. Deputies checked and located one person on the premise that had permission to be there per the owners.
12/6	Fernwood La.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person entered his unlocked vehicle and stole some change from inside.
12/6	Center Terr.	Customer Trouble	A Cab Driver stated that a subject skipped the fare and entered the apartment complex. Deputies located the subject who returned and paid for the service.
12/6	Accident PDO	Beaver La.	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
12/7	Alvin Rd.	Larceny	Employees of Fucillo Toyota state that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole various car parts from vehicles on the sales lot.
12/7	Grand Island Blvd.	Unknown Trouble	The complainant states that a male subject was lying on the side of the road. Deputies located the male who was resting and gave him a courtesy ride home.
12/7	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was going door to door soliciting for window sales. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject by the description given.
12/7	Foxcroft St.	Barking Dog	The complainant states that dogs were barking at a nearby residence for several hours. The dogs ceased barking prior to the arrival of Patrol.

12/9	Love Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
12/10	East River Rd.	Suspicious Person	Deputies located a suspicious person walking during the late hours of the night. The subject was advised.
12/10	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that dogs were barking for hours from a neighbor's apartment in his complex and he was worried something happened. Deputies were unable to make contact with the occupants.
12/10	I-190	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
12/10	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a subject wearing dark clothing and gloves was walking around the outside of Theodore's. Deputies located the subject who was advised and left without incident.
12/11	Stony Point Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that he believed someone was inside of his van stealing items during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any persons. Nothing was reported stolen or damaged from the vehicle.
12/11	Staley Rd.	Road Obstruction	Deputies responded to a report of a tree down blocking the roadway. The tree was removed.
12/11	Baseline Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call. Deputies were able to make contact with the occupant and determined the call was a misdial.
12/11	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that 2 subjects were outside of his basement apartment window and seemed to be smoking something. Deputies checked and determined the complaint was unfounded.
12/11	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Deputies located 2 vehicles outside of the Grand Island Deli after closing hours. It was determined the vehicles belonged to the owners who were on scene.
12/11	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Deputies located a vehicle outside of Kelly's Country Store during the late hours of the night. It was determined the vehicle belonged to one of the owners who was on scene.
