The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 171 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
12/6	Marjorie Dr.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that 2 female subjects were going door to door carrying large handbags. Deputies located the females nearby and determined they were soliciting in the area.
12/6	Baseline Rd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a pickup truck was tailgating other vehicles and driving recklessly on the roadway. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
12/6	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle followed her for approximately 80 miles while she was traveling home. The vehicle was last seen near the south Grand Island Bridge. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
12/6	Marlin Dr.	Shots Fired	The complainant states he heard 2 gun shots near his residence. Deputies checked the area but were unable to hear any shots.
12/7	Marjorie Dr.	Residential Fire	Deputies assisted the Grand Island Fire Department with a report of a house fire. Erie County Sheriffs Fire Investigation Unit was also requested to the scene for assistance in investigation. The cause of the fire was determined to be accidental. No injuries were reported by any of the occupants who were all able to escape the residence.
12/7	Fix Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states she found a small black dog on her porch. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
12/7	Whitehaven Rd.	ATV Complaint	The complainant states that 3 youths were riding ATV's back and forth across the roadway. Deputies located the youths and advised them.
12/8	South State Pkwy	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a male subject was riding a motorized wheelchair in traffic and the complainant almost struck him. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject.
12/8	Pellamwood Ct.	Youth Activity	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) egged his house. No damage was reported.

12/8	Grand Island Blvd.	Burglary	The complainant states that sometime over the weekend and unknown person(s) broke into several storage units and stole items from inside. Investigation Ongoing.
12/9	Schutt Ct.	Open Door	The complainant states the door to a neighboring house was open and it did not appear that anyone was home. Deputies checked the residence but found no persons inside. The open door was determined to be an oversight.
12/9	Grand Island Blvd.	Warrant Arrests	While investigating an unrelated complaint, Deputies arrested 37 y/o Jermain Greene of Buffalo and 22 y/o Felicia Clark of Grand Island after the subjects were found to have outstanding warrants from the Town of Amherst. The subjects were transferred to the custody of the Amherst Police Department.
12/9	Sandy Beach Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that her daughter was walking home when she was approached by a male subject who asked if anyone was home with her. The subject then offered to take her to get something to eat. The child immediately ran to her residence and the incident was reported to Patrol. The vehicle was last seen driving southbound on Sandy Beach Rd. The subject is described as a white male, in his 40's, short brown hair, round glasses, facial hair on his chin, wearing a green t-shirt, and was driving a red SUV type vehicle. 12/9	Bush Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
12/9	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Incident	The manager of Tops states that a male subject came into the store and attempted to buy several hundred dollars worth of gift certificates with a credit card. When asked for identification, the subject fled the store prompting employees to believe the credit card may be stolen. The subject entered a vehicle and left the area. Deputies checked the area for the vehicle but were unable to locate it.

Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states a vehicle was parked in front of his house during the late hours of the night and the driver was claiming he was out of gas but the complainant thought he was acting strange. When the complainant went inside to call 911 the driver disappeared. Deputies located the subject nearby and determined the vehicle was out of fuel. The driver was assisted by a family member in obtaining fuel and removed the vehicle from the roadway.
