The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 237 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

Date	Type	Street	Narrative
12/13	UUMV	Speedway	Deputies received a call from a male stating that his Jeep was stolen by a female prostitute. Male picked up the female and brought her to Grand Island, ran inside Speedway to grab something, and the female drove away with his vehicle. Vehicle was located by Buffalo PD when the female bailed out of the vehicle during a traffic stop. Male only wanted his vehicle back and did not wish to file charges.
12/14	Larceny	WellNow	Deputies were called by the district manager of WellNow in regards to employee theft of cash overnight. Deputies are investigating further and a police report was filed.
12/15	Mental	Grand Island Substation	Deputies were approached at the substation by a male looking to talk with patrol. After a short conversation the subject was found to be in need of a mental examination. Deputies called for an ambulance to transport the subject but he quickly became combative with patrol. Subject was detained and transported to ECMC on MHL 9.41 papers.
12/16	Unwelcome Guest	Grand Island Bd	Deputies received a call about unwelcome tenants that were supposed to be off the premises. Deputies spoke with the owner and made aware that they have until 5PM to clear all their property. All parties were advised.
12/16	Accident Hit and Run	East River Rd.	Homeowner called deputies to report that someone hit a pole and his pool and left the scene. Deputies were given the plate of the vehicle and it was later found down the road unoccupied. The vehicle was impounded and the driver came to the station at a later date where he was issued several citations for the accident. Police report completed.
12/17	Larceny from vehicle	Oakridge Dr.	Deputies investigated a vehicle entered overnight on Oakridge Dr. Owners wallet with credit cards was taken as well as his cologne. No charges were made, report filed.
