The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 155 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
12/12	Colonial Dr. West	Suspicious Person	The complainant states a male subject was going door to door soliciting for a carpet cleaning service. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject by the description given.
12/12	Love Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that he found a sneaker in his yard. Deputies located the sneaker and checked the area but found nothing out of order.
12/13	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident in the parking lot of Brick Oven Pizza. No injuries were reported.
12/13	Broadway	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that it appeared a neighbor's house was broken in to. Deputies located a damaged door on the residence but it did not appear entry was gained. The house is currently vacant and nothing appeared to be stolen.
12/13	South State Pkwy.	Traffic Arrest / Criminal Impersonation	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 36 y/o Ryan McCleary of Buffalo for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 2 nd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. McCleary was also charged with Criminal Impersonation 2 nd Degree (Class A Misdemeanor) after he attempted to lie about his identity to Deputies. McCleary was transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$250 bail.
12/14	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a "spooky looking" male subject was hanging around outside of the Jade Inn Motel. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any persons matching the description.
12/14	Love Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a subject was inside the garage of a nearby house that was up for sale. Deputies located the subject and determined she was a family member.
12/14	Whitehaven Rd.	Larceny	Employees of Ace Hardware state that a male subject stole various items from the store and left on foot. Deputies located the subject nearby who was returned to the store. The items were returned and employees did

			not wish to pursue any charges.
12/14	Love Rd.	Road Obstruction	Deputies responded to a report of 2 trees that fell and were in the roadway. The Grand Island Highway Department responded and removed the debris.
12/15	Baseline Rd.	Road Obstruction	Deputies removed a large bag of garbage that had blown into the roadway.
12/15	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Deputies located an occupied vehicle at the Nike Base during the late hours of the night. An intoxicated male subject was found inside. Family members were contacted and retrieved the male subject and his vehicle. The subject was cited for an open container of an alcoholic beverage inside of a motor vehicle (infraction).
12/15	Bedell Rd.	Road Rage	The complainant states she witnessed 2 other drivers cursing and yelling at each other near the intersection of Grand Island Blvd. Deputies located one of the drivers by the license plate obtained by the complainant. The driver was advised.
12/16	Grand Island Blvd.	Attempted Larceny	Employees of Tops state that a male subject came into the store and attempted to steal a large amount of steaks before becoming nervous and fleeing without the merchandise. The subject entered a dark colored car and fled westbound onto Whitehaven Rd. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
12/16	Fix Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that several of his coyote traps were missing and appeared to be stolen.
12/16	South La.	Animal Loose	The complainant states that her dog got loose and was running around in the area. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
12/16	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a male subject was yelling and throwing himself against the glass at the bus stop. Deputies located the male subject and advised him. No damage was observed to the bus stop.
12/17	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Deputies located a vehicle parked at Grand Island Auto Tech during the late hours of the night. It was determined the driver was dropping the car off for service.
12/17	East River Rd.	Barking Dog	The complainant states that a dog was barking in the area for approximately 15 minutes. Deputies checked the area and determined the complaint was unfounded.
12/17	Stony Point Rd.	Unknown Trouble	The complainant states that a male driver was slumped over behind the wheel of a black pickup truck near the intersection of Whitehaven Rd. Deputies checked the area and determined the complaint was unfounded.
12/17	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident in the parking lot of Wendy's. No injuries were reported.
12/17	Stony Point Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states that a dog was running loose in the area under the South Grand Island Bridge. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
12/17	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	The complainant, a resident of a nursing home, states that money was stolen from her wallet. Investigation Ongoing.

12/17	East River Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was walking down the road screaming during the late evening hours. Deputies checked but determined the complaint was unfounded.
12/18	Baseline Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states she found a dog running loose in the area. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
12/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Fight	Deputies responded to a report of a fight at Cinderella Motel & Campground. 2 males involved were located and 1 was treated for seemingly nonlife threatening injuries. Neither subject was interested in pursuing charges, both were advised and left without incident.
12/18	Love Rd.	Parking Complaint	The complainant states that numerous vehicles were parked in the fire lane at Kaegabine Elementary School. Deputies checked the premise and determined the complaint was unfounded.
12/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident in the parking lot of Wendy's. No injuries were reported.
