



Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 172 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
12/13	Town Hall Terr.	Stolen Vehicle Recovered	The complainant states that a vehicle in the parking lot of the apartment complex was stuck in the snow bank and had a broken window. A check of the vehicles plates determined that the vehicle was reported stolen from the City of Buffalo. No persons were seen driving the vehicle before it was parked in the lot. The vehicle was impounded and notification was made to Buffalo Police Department.
12/13	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject knocked on her door and was asking to be let inside. The male left prior to the arrival of Patrol. Deputies spoke with a manager on scene that saw the subject and identified him as a former tenant. Deputies located the subject at his place of employment and advised him to stay away from the complainant's residence.
12/13	Sheree Dr.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that it seemed an unknown person(s) entered her residence sometime in recent days. Deputies checked the residence and determined the complaint to be unfounded.
12/13	Carl Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that she arrived home and found her rear door open. Deputies checked the residence but found no persons inside. Nothing was reported missing and the door was determined to be an oversight.
12/13	Third St.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states a suspicious vehicle was parked in her driveway during the late evening hours. It was determined that the vehicle belonged to a friend.
12/14	Carter Creek Dr.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person slashed all 4 of the tires on his vehicle.
12/14	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject in a mobile wheelchair was sitting on the side of the road near the thruway and appeared to be sleeping or deceased. Deputies located the male subject who stated he was waiting for the bus to arrive.
12/14	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states that several male subjects were near an SUV in the parking lot of Key Bank and

			appeared to be looking into vacant cars and the bank itself. Deputies determined the group was a tailgate party that returned from the Buffalo Bills game in a limo.
12/14	Bedell Rd.	Warrant Arrest	Deputies arrested 44 y/o Mark Dlugokinski of Grand Island after serving bench warrants at his apartment. Dlugokinski had 2 outstanding Bench Warrants from the Town of Gouverneur and the Town of Grand Island. Dlugokinski was transferred to the custody of the New York State Police.
12/15	Fernwood La.	Suspicious Person with vehicle	The complainant states that a male subject was sitting in a vehicle outside of her residence for approximately a half hour. Deputies located the vehicle and determined the male subject was a NYS Auditor and had an appointment at a nearby house.
12/15	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that he observed a male subject shoulder the door open to a nearby residence. A vehicle parked in the driveway of the residence then immediately pulled out and left the area. Deputies checked the residence and determined the male subject lived inside the residence in question and had locked himself out of his own home.
12/15	Long Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states that yesterday, a vehicle occupied by 3 females was sitting outside her residence. One of the females waved to the complainant's daughter when she opened the curtains to the window. The complainant only wanted to make Patrol aware of the incident.
12/15	Fix Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
12/16	Sandy Beach Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) entered her unlocked vehicle. Nothing was reported missing. In talking with neighbors it was determined that 1 witness was confronted by a male subject getting out of her vehicle during the night. The male subject stated he was "sorry" and "was just looking for some change" before fleeing on foot. The male subject was described as a Hispanic Male, approximately 5'8" tall, with a medium build. 12/16	Grand Island Blvd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a pickup truck with a trailer attached cut off several vehicles while traveling on the I-190. The vehicle then exited at Grand Island Blvd. where the complainant lost sight of it. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
12/17	Evelyn Ct.	Barking Dog	The complainant states that a dog was barking somewhere in the neighborhood for the last several hours. Deputies located the dog but were unable to make contact with any occupants of the residence. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
12/17	Ward Park Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that 3 teenagers were going

			through a neighbor's car. The subjects triggered a motion light in the area, and then fled on foot. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subjects. Nothing was reported stolen.
12/17	Foxcroft St.	Residential Fire	Deputies assisted the Grand Island Fire Department with a report of a dryer fire. No occupants were hurt and the fire was extinguished by Grand Island Fire.
12/17	Grand Island Blvd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call at Tim Hortons / Wendys. Deputies checked the businesses but were unable to locate anyone in need of police assistance.
12/18	Ransom Rd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that vehicles cut through the gas station on the corner of Stony Point Rd. to avoid traffic around the time that the High School is dismissing students for the day.
12/18	Creekside Dr.	Residential Fire	Deputies assisted the Grand Island Fire Department with a report of a dryer fire. No occupants were hurt and the fire was extinguished by Grand Island Fire.
12/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Disorderly Person	The complainant states that a male subject seemed intoxicated and was yelling at patrons. Deputies located the male subject and advised him. The subject left without incident.
12/18	South State Pkwy.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle was speeding down the road and ran through several stop signs. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
12/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that as he was driving by the NFTA Bus Stop near the intersection of Staley Rd. he observed a male subject who appeared to be damaging the bus stop. Deputies located the male subject and determined he was acting out "wrestling moves". No damage to the bus stop was observed.
12/18	Queens Dr.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that he heard someone open the rear door to his residence. Deputies checked the residence and the rear yard but found no persons. No damage was observed and nothing was reported stolen.
12/18	Love Rd.	Robbery	The complainant states she was accosted and robbed by a known male subject. Deputies investigation led to the arrest of 20 y/o Robert Rovison Jr. of Grand Island who was found hiding in a nearby residence. Rovison was charged with Robbery 3 rd Degree (Class D Felony), Petit Larceny (Class A Misdemeanor), 2 counts of Criminal Mischief 4 th Degree (Class A Misdemeanor), Harassment 2 nd Degree (Violation) and Obstruction of Governmental Administration 2 nd Degree (Class A Misdemeanor). During the investigation, a Juvenile Offender was also arrested after he was found to be in possession of the stolen property. The Juvenile Offender was charged with Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 5 th Degree (Class A Misdemeanor) and Obstruction of Governmental Administration 2 nd Degree (Class A Misdemeanor). Both subjects were transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending their

			arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.
12/19	Whitehaven Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
12/19	West Park Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked at a nearby vacant house. No person was observed around the vehicle. The house was checked and appeared to be in order.
12/19	Baseline Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that sometime in recent nights, an unknown person(s) tampered with his pool causing it to collapse.
12/19	East River Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	The complainant states that during the previous night, an unknown vehicle struck her mailbox. The vehicle then fled the scene in an unknown direction.
12/19	Alvin Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call at Fucillo Chevrolet. Deputies checked and determined the call was a misdial.
12/19	I-190	Reckless Operation	The complainant states a vehicle was swerving while driving on the South Grand Island Bridge and then exited onto South State Pkwy. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
12/19	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle / Marijuana Arrest	The complainant states that a suspicious vehicle just parked behind a business that was closed during the late evening hours. Deputies investigation led to the arrest of 28 y/o Philip Henderson of Grand Island for Unlawful Possession of Marijuana (Violation). Henderson was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.

Deputies responded to 5 Burglary False alarm calls and 4 Fire Alarms during the dates of this report.
