The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 170 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

11/21	Colonial Dr. East	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that several subjects with flashlights were in a neighbor's yard looking at a boat. Deputies located the subjects and confirmed with the neighbor that the boat was for sale and the subjects were there as prospective buyers.
11/21	Whitehaven Rd.	Noise Complaint	The complainant states that loud music was coming from a nearby residence during the late evening hours. Deputies located the source of the music and advised the occupant to turn it down.
11/21	Whitehaven Rd.	Noise Complaint	The complainant states that a nearby residence was playing loud music during the late hours of the night. Deputies spoke with the occupants and advised them.

11/23	South La.	Fraud	<p>The complainant states that he received a call from an unknown number and the male on the line stated he was from the IRS and the complainant owed back tax money. The complaint was directed to purchase several gift cards and gave the numbers to the alleged agent over the phone. After the money was withdrawn by the unknown subject(s) the complainant realized he had been scammed and contacted Patrol. The Erie County Sheriff's Office reminds everyone not to give out personal information over the phone or conduct any transaction without first checking the legitimacy of the caller.</p>

Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 28 y/o John Ryan of Grand Island for Driving a Motor Vehicle with a suspended registration (misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV checked showed his license plates were suspended. Ryan was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.

		of Marijuana	smoking marijuana in the basement laundry room of an apartment complex during the late hours of the night. Deputies investigation led to the arrests of 21 y/o Robert Rovison, 30 y/o Randall Blair, and 3 Juvenile Offenders all of Grand Island for Criminal Possession of Marijuana 5 th Degree (B Misdemeanor). 1 Juvenile Offender was additionally charged with Criminal Possession of a Weapon 4 th Degree (Class A Misdemeanor). All of the subjects were issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
11/25	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Webb Rd. No injuries were reported.
11/25	Baseline Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call at a residence. Patrol spoke to the occupants and determined the call was a misdial.
11/25	East River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that he could hear noises in his backyard during the late evening hours and was unsure what was causing it. Deputies checked the yard but found nothing out of order.
11/25	South State Pkwy.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
11/25	Grand Island Blvd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 46 y/o Gregory Dinsmore of Grand Island for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Dinsmore was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
