The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 341 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

11/23	Disturbance Other	E. Park Rd.	Deputies responded to a disturbance between two parties. One party was upset that the other party would not take them to purchase marijuana. All parties advised.
11/24	DWI/Alcohol	Bedell Rd.	Deputies responded to a car vs. mailbox accident. The driver exhibited signs of intoxication. The driver complained of pain and refused all sobriety testing as well as breath or blood test. Subject transported for medical evaluation and charged with DWI. The driver was released on UTTs at the hospital and the vehicle was towed with a twelve-hour hold.

Driver was detained for DWI. Driver was taken to the Sheriff's station and refused a chemical test. Subject released to a sober third party on traffic tickets and the vehicle was placed on a twelve-hour hold.
11/29	Shoplifting	Grand Island Blvd	Deputies received a call from a store manager reporting that a subject stole batteries. Deputies quickly located the suspect. The subject was detained and taken to the Sheriff's station and charged with shoplifting / petit larceny, and released on appearance ticket.
