The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 243 calls the weeks of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on Grand Island.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
2/3	River Oaks Drive	Unwelcome Guest	Deputies responded to a report of an unwelcome guest. Subject advised by patrol and left without incident.
