The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 261 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

Date	Type	Street	Narrative
2/7	Larceny	Rite Aid	Deputies received a call from the manager at Rite Aid in regards to an employee theft of a controlled substance. Deputies investigated and subsequently arrested the employee for the theft. Subject was processed and issued an appearance ticket
2/7	Larceny	Grand Island Small Animal Hospital	Deputies were called by employees for a male who left with \$900 worth of pet medications. Subject applied for cost assistance but was denied, he ran outside to get money from friend and never came back. Contact could not be made with the subject so a warrant was requested by patrol.
2/9	Traffic Stop/ Arrest	I-190 @ Whitehaven Rd.	Deputies initiated a traffic stop on a gray Chevrolet sedan for a headlight out. After speaking with the driver, it was found that he had 10 suspensions on his license. Subject was arrested and later released to a friend.
2/12	Suspicious Person	The Commons St.	Deputies received a call from homeowner who's out of town and spoke to male at his front door. The male, who was walking with a cane, was told to leave but continues to walk around the home outside. Deputies checked the area and around the house, no one was seen in the area.
2/12	Traffic Stop/ Arrest	I-190 @ Whitehaven Rd.	Deputies initiated a traffic stop on a red Lincoln SUV for a suspended registration for insurance lapse. After speaking with the driver he was found to have a suspended driver's license. He was detained and issued tickets for his violations.
