The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 160 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
2/9	Baseline Rd	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a vehicle had driven into a snow bank and briefly become stuck. The driver of the vehicle was able to free the vehicle and left the scene. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.
2/9	East River Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a vehicle that had struck a mailbox. The vehicle was no longer on scene.
2/9	Grand Island Blvd.	Customer Trouble	A taxi cab driver stated he had a fare that was unable to pay. Deputies spoke to the subjects who made arrangements to pay the driver. All parties were advised and payment was made.
2/9	East Park Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
2/9	Timberlink Dr.	Snowmobile Operation	Complainant states that several snowmobiles were operating on the sidewalk of her street. Deputies located the snowmobiles and advised the owners.
2/9	Beaver Island State Park	Snowmobile Operation	Complainant states that several snowmobiles were operating on the golf course in Beaver Island State Park. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the snowmobiles.
2/9	Grand Island Blvd.	Animal Complaint	Complainant states that a dog was left in a vehicle unattended for 20 minutes and was worried due to the frigid temperatures. Deputies located the owner of the vehicle and advised her. The dog appeared to be in good health.
2/9	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that a suspicious male was walking on Grand Island Blvd. Deputies located the subject who was walking to a local business.
2/9	Ransom Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call at Grand Island High School. Deputies spoke to school staff and determined no one was in need of police assistance.
2/10	Baseline Rd.	Animal Loose	Complainant states that a dog was running loose in the neighborhood. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
2/10	Ransom Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.

2/10	Oak Harbor Rd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that a male subject was walking through the neighborhood without a coat on and appeared to be acting suspiciously. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject.
2/11	Whitehaven Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
2/11	Carl Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that sometime during the night an unknown person(s) stole a bank card from her vehicle. Upon further investigation, the complainant found her bank card which she had misplaced.
2/11	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that a male subject was walking in the roadway on Grand Island Blvd. Deputies located the subject and advised him.
2/11	Alvin Rd.	Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle	Employees at Fucillo Chevrolet state that a former employee had borrowed a vehicle and had not returned it. Deputies investigation led to the arrest of Zackry Conover of Orchard Park for Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle 3 rd Degree (Class A Misdemeanor). Conover was issued and appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
2/12	Whitehaven Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
2/12	Rob Roy Pkwy	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that 2 subjects came to her door and tried the handle. Deputies located the subjects who were employees of a window installation company. The subjects were advised.
2/12	West River Rd.	Animal Loose	Complainant states that 2 dogs came from an address on West River Rd. and attempted to attack her while she was walking her dog. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
2/12	Center Court North	Shots Fired	Complainant states that he heard shots fired in the area of Town Hall Terrace. Deputies were unable to locate the source. No further shots were reported.
2/12	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
2/13	East River Rd.	Barking Dog	Complainant states that a dog was barking late at night for several hours. Deputies located the dog but were unable to contact the owner. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
2/13	Ransom Rd.	Disturbance	Complainant states that she had a verbal altercation with another parent at Grand Island High School regarding a parking spot. Both parties were advised.
2/13	Bedell Rd.	Wire Down	Complainant states that the electrical wires to his residence had been ripped down, possibly by a passing truck.
2/13	Tracey La.	Loud Music	Complainant states that a neighbor was playing music very loudly. Deputies spoke to the subject and advised him.
2/13	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that a male subject appeared to be looking in car windows in the Grand Island Plaza parking lot. The subject then boarded the bus heading toward Niagara Falls. Deputies located the subject on the bus and advised him. Nothing was reported taken.

2/14	West River Rd.	Marijuana Possession	Complainant states that a vehicle was stuck in the snow in his front yard and 2 subjects were trying to push it out. Deputies investigation led to the arrest of a Juvenile Offender for Unlawful Possession of Marijuana. The Juvenile Offender was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
2/14	Long Rd.	Wire Down	Deputies responded to a report of wires down on Long Rd. Deputies and Grand Island Fire Department checked but were unable to locate any wires down.
2/14	Baseline Rd.	Traffic Control Device	Deputies located a traffic signal at Baseline Rd. and Bedell Rd. that was inoperable. Grand Island Highway Department was notified.
2/14	Bedell Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
2/14	Center Court South	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that while he was in his apartment he thought he heard someone open the door and walk in. Deputies checked the area but did not find anything suspicious in nature. Nothing was reported missing.
2/14	Grand Island Blvd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a 911 hang up call at a local business. Deputies determined the call to be a false alarm.
2/15	Huth Rd.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a vehicle was swerving all over the roadway. Deputies checked but were unable to locate the vehicle.
2/15	Bedell Rd.	Larceny	Complainant states that sometime during the night an unknown person(s) stole a small amount of change from his unlocked vehicle.
2/15	Brandywine Dr.	Youth Activity	Complainant states that several youths were playing in the wooded area around her residence. Deputies checked but were unable to locate the youths.
2/15	Hennepin Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that sometime in recent months an unknown person(s) stole various items of jewelry from her residence. Upon further investigation the complainant found the jewelry which she had hidden and forgot about.
