The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 158 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on Grand Island.

| 2/15 | Baseline Rd. | Suspicious Incident | The complainant states that a male subject on a porch and yelling for an unknown reason. Deputies located the subject who stated he was yelling at a nearby barking dog. |
| 2/15 | South State Pkwy | Suspicious Incident | The complainant states that a teenager got out of a vehicle and began to yell at the car as it sped off. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject or the vehicle. |
