The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 435 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

02/15	Traffic Stop	Baseline Rd.	Deputies initiated a traffic stop for violations. DMV check revealed the vehicle operator was driving with a suspended license. The driver was arrested and released on UTTs.
02/16	DWI/Alcohol	Baseline Rd.	Deputies were dispatched for a report of a vehicle striking guardrails on the Grand Island Bridge and operating recklessly. Deputies located the vehicle, observed and initiated a traffic stop. The driver exhibited signs of intoxication. The vehicle operator was charged with DWI and released on UTTs.
02/16	Animal Attack	Grand Island Bd.	Deputies received report from a complainant that stated that their cat was attacking them and that they are locked in a room away from the animal. Deputies arrived and the cat was calm. The complainant required no further assistance.
02/18	Welfare Check	Grand Island Bd.	Deputies received a call from management that a subject is slumped at the wheel of a vehicle in the parking lot of a business. Deputies checked on him and he was just resting.
02/19	Trespass	Grand Island Bd.	Deputies received a complaint from security of a closed business that two subjects are trespassing on the property. The subjects attempted to flee in a vehicle as patrol arrived and they were stopped. Both subjects were arrested for trespass and released on UTTs.
02/19	Loose Animal	Grand Island Bd.	Deputies responded to five loose horses on the ramp to the I-190. The horses were located trying to roam onto the highway. Patrol did corral them with assistance. ** Deputies responded to 10 Business Burglary Alarms this
