The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 166 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
1/24	East Park Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked in the driveway across the street from his residence during the late hours of the night and did not appear to belong there.
1/24	Bruce La.	Larceny	The complainant states that a known male subject stole various items while at the complainant's home. Deputies investigation led to the arrest of 20 y/o Paul Mosher of Grand Island for Grand Larceny 3 rd Degree (Class D Felony) and Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 3 rd Degree (Class D Felony). Some of the items were recovered during the investigation. Mosher was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending his arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.
1/24	Carl Rd.	Residential Burglary	The complainant states that sometime in recent days, an unknown person(s) kicked in the door to her mother's home and stole various items while inside. Erie County Sheriff's Office Detectives responded and with information learned from the previous night's larceny complaint, they arrested 20 y/o Paul Mosher of Grand Island for Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 4 th Degree (Class E Felony). Property from this Burglary was also recovered in the joint investigation of the previous night's incident. More charges are pending against Mosher.
1/24	Fix Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) damaged his mailbox.
1/24	East River Rd.	Alarm Ringing / Open Door	Deputies responded to a report of a burglary alarm at a residence on East River Rd. Upon arrival, Deputies located an open door to the premise. The house was searched and no sign of a disturbance or persons were found inside.
1/24	Whitehaven Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident at the intersection of White Oak Lane. No injuries were reported.
1/24	Stony Point Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a fire hydrant. No injuries were

			reported and the Grand Island Highway Department was notified regarding the damaged hydrant.
1/24	Alt Blvd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
1/25	Staley Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Deputies located a suspicious occupied vehicle parked at St. Timothy's Lutheran Church during the late hours of the night. The occupants were advised and left without incident.
1/25	South State Pkwy.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 24 y/o Tylor Higgins of Kenmore for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and a traffic infraction after a check showed his license was currently suspended. Higgins was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
1/25	Long Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
1/25	Ransom Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states he observed a packet filled with white powder while walking his dog at Grand Island High School. Patrol determined the substance to be a mint candy that had been crushed and the item was discarded in the trash.
1/25	Love Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states she found a dog wandering in the roadway. The Dog Control Officer was notified and took custody of the animal.
1/26	Fernwood La.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked in his neighbor's driveway during the late hours of the night and didn't think it belonged there. Deputies checked and determined the owner of the vehicle was completing repair work inside the residence.
1/26	Whitehaven Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer at the intersection of Stony Point Rd. No injuries were reported.
1/26	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states that a suspicious occupied vehicle was parked in the rear lot of Byblos Niagara Resort & Spa and had been there for some time. Deputies spoke with the occupants and advised them.
1/26	Grand Island Blvd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
1/26	Webb Rd.	Snowmobile Complaint	The complainant states that several snowmobiles were running up and down the street. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicles.
1/26	Stony Point Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	The complainant states that a vehicle just struck a pole and took out a few mailboxes before fleeing the scene. While Deputies were on scene investigating, a female arrived on scene and identified her son as the driver of the vehicle. Deputies located the subject at his residence and issued him several traffic citations.
1/26	Staley Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle pulled into his driveway during the late hours of the night and then turned its headlights off. It was determined the vehicle had become disabled and was towed shortly after.
1/26	Old Carriage House Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported and the driver was

			issued several traffic infractions after a check showed the vehicle was unregistered.
1/27	Stony Point Rd.	Accident PDO / Drunk Driving	Deputies responded to a report of a vehicle in a ditch. Their investigation led to the arrest of 43 y/o Shannon Mills of Grand Island for Driving While Intoxicated and other traffic infractions. Mills registered a .15% B.A.C. after submitting a sample of her breath for chemical analysis. Mills was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
1/27	Bedell Rd.	Parking Complaint	The complaint states that a vehicle was unlawfully parked in a handicap spot in the parking lot of her apartment complex. Deputies located the owner of the vehicle who agreed to move the car.
1/27	Deerwood La.	Alarm Ringing / Open Door	Deputies responded to a report of a burglary alarm at a residence on Deerwood La. Upon arrival, Deputies located an open door to the premise. The house was searched and no sign of a disturbance or persons were found inside.
1/27	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Incident	An employee of the Grand Island Deli states that 2 subjects locked themselves inside the bathroom of the business and refused to come out. Prior to the arrival of Patrol the subjects left the bathroom, entered a white vehicle before fleeing southbound on Grand Island Blvd. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given. No damage was observed to the bathroom.
1/27	Town Hall Te.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that an unoccupied vehicle was in the parking lot and had been running for several hours. Deputies located the RO and determined that her boyfriend started her vehicle earlier in the morning but did not know that she called in sick to work.
1/28	East Park Rd.	Parking Complaint	The complainant states that several vehicles were illegally parked near the intersection of Hennepin Rd. and were prohibiting a school bus from passing. Deputies checked and determined the complaint to be unfounded.
1/28	Baseline Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident in the parking lot of Town Hall Terr. No injuries were reported.
1/28	Whitehaven Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident in the parking lot of Noco. No injuries were reported.
1/28	Ransom Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that his son's cell phone was missing from his locker at Grand Island High School. Prior to the arrival of Patrol, it was determined the phone was mistakenly taken by a friend of the complainant's son. The phone was returned.
1/29	Baseline Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 26 y/o Anthony Burge of Niagara Falls for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and a traffic infraction after a check showed his license was currently suspended. Burge was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.

1/29	Whitehaven Rd.	Larceny	An employee of Noco states that a male subject stole various bundles of fire wood from the lot of the store. The store video surveillance cameras were able to catch the suspect on tape and Deputies developed a suspect using the footage. Investigation Ongoing.
1/29	Love Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Blackmon Rd. No injuries were reported.
1/29	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a street sign. No injuries were reported.
1/30	Alt Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident near the intersection of Love Rd. No injuries were reported.
1/30	Whitehaven Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
1/30	West River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states he thought he observed an orange duffle on the side of the road but upon further inspection he realized it was a person. The subject then walked toward the water and the complainant lost sight of him. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject.
1/30	East River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that she heard a loud bang that shook her house. Deputies checked the area but found nothing out of order.

Deputies responded to 6 Burglary False alarm calls and 7 Fire Alarms during the dates of this report.
