The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 187 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

1/26	Staley Rd.	Suspicious Person	Deputies observed a male subject walking during the late hours of the night. The subject was advised.
1/26	Long Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Complainant states that a vehicle was broken down in the area of Long Rd. and the I-190 overpass. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate vehicles broken down.
1/26	Staley Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.

The subject shoved her aside, stole her purse, and fled on foot into the Country Glen Apartment Complex. The suspect was described as approximately 5'4" tall and had a thin build. Deputies, along with the assistance of a K9 Unit, searched the area but were unable to locate the suspect. 1/26	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Person	Deputies located a male subject walking during the late evening hours. The subject was advised.
1/26	Whitehaven Rd.	Drunk Driving	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. Their investigation led to the arrest of 22 y/o Autumn Urbaniak of Buffalo for Driving While Intoxicated, Unlawful Possession of Marijuana (Violation), Criminal Possession of a Controlled

			Substance 7 th Degree (Class A Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions. Urbaniak registered a .11% B.A.C. after submitting a sample of her breath for chemical analysis. Urbaniak was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and then released to a sober 3 rd party.
1/27	East River Rd.	Drunk Driving	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested a Juvenile Offender for Driving While Intoxicated and other traffic infractions. The Juvenile Offender registered a .09% B.A.C. after submitting a sample of his breath for chemical analysis. The Juvenile Offender was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and then released to a sober 3 rd party.
1/27	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Person	Deputies located a male subject walking on Baseline Rd. near the pipeline. The subject was advised.
1/27	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 3 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
1/27	Ransom Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	Complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person struck his parked vehicle with their car. Minor damage was done to the complainant's vehicle.
1/27	Stony Point Rd.	Shots Fired	Complainant states that he heard several shots fired in the area of his residence. Deputies determined the shots to be coming from the gun club.

1/29	Bedell Rd.	Residential Burglary	Complainant states that sometime during the day, an unknown person stole various items from her apartment. Investigation Ongoing.
1/29	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states he found various empty alcoholic beverage containers in the basement of his apartment complex. No damage was observed.
1/30	Center Court North	Loud Music	Complainant states that loud music was coming from an apartment in his complex. Deputies spoke to the

			occupants of the address in question and advised them.
1/30	Long Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that a subject was cutting down a tree on the Dunlop Tire Corporation Property. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject.
1/30	Alvin Rd.	Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle	Employees at Fucillo Chevrolet state that a vehicle was stolen from the sales lot sometime in the past week. Investigation Ongoing.
1/31	Stony Point Rd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that 2 subjects were standing next to his residence when he pulled into his driveway. The subjects then fled in an unknown direction. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subjects. No damage was observed.
1/31	Whitehaven Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call. The call was determined to be a problem with the phone lines.
1/31	Stony Point Rd.	Wire Down	Deputies responded to a report of low hanging wires in the roadway.
1/31	Long Rd.	Open Door/Window	Complainant states that a door to his neighbor's residence was open and it did not appear his neighbor was home. Deputies checked the residence and found nothing out of order. The door was secured.
2/1	Whitehaven Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following an investigation of a motorist broke down, Deputies arrested 23 y/o William Hurley of Central Square NY for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree and other traffic infractions. Also arrested was the passenger of the vehicle, 23 y/o Garrett Lazore of Central Square NY. Lazore is charged with Obstruction of Governmental Administration 2 nd Degree (Class A Misdemeanor) and Resisting Arrest (Class A Misdemeanor). Hurley and Lazore were transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending their arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.
2/1	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Complainant states that a suspicious vehicle was parked in the Nike Base parking lot during the early morning hours. Deputies located the owner and advised him. No damage was observed on the premise.
2/1	Baseline Rd.	Warrant Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 34 y/o Mark Beauchamp of Grand Island after a check showed he had an outstanding Bench Warrant from Town of Niagara Court. Beauchamp was turned over to the custody of the Town of Niagara Police Department.
2/1	Bedell Rd.	Loud Music	Complainant states that loud music was coming from an apartment in her complex. Deputies spoke to the occupants of the apartment in question and advised them.
2/1	Grand Island Blvd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
