



## Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 173 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

2/27	Bedell Rd.	Noise Complaint	The complainant states that a neighbor in his apartment complex was still blasting his music during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked and determined the complaint was unfounded.
2/27	Bedell Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
2/27	Long Rd.	Warrant Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 51 y/o Keith Gaskin of Grand Island after a checked determined he had 2 outstanding warrants from the City of Buffalo and the NFTA Police Department. Gaskin was transferred to the custody of the NFTA Police Department.
2/27	East River Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states that a dog was roaming around the neighborhood. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
2/27	Bedell Rd.	Noise Complaint	The complainant states that loud music was coming from a nearby apartment in his complex at the Country Glen during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the apartment in question and advised the occupants.
2/27	Stony Point Rd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a vehicle was swerving all over the road during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the vehicle which was unoccupied in the driveway of the registered owner.
2/28	Love Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states that she found a dog wandering around during the late hours of the night. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
2/28	Grand Island Blvd.	Property Found	The complainant states she found a wallet in the roadway and wanted to turn it over to Patrol. Deputies used an ID located inside to contact the owner and the wallet was returned.
2/28	Elmwood Rd.	Animal Loose	Deputies found a dog wandering loose in the neighborhood. The dog was returned to the owner who lived nearby.
2/29	Revere Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that she found hundreds of holes in her siding that seemed to be from a BB Gun. Investigation Ongoing.

2/29	Grand Island Blvd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a vehicle drove into the parking lot of the Family Dollar with a child that was not belted into a car seat. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
2/29	Whitehaven Rd.	Traffic Arrest / Warrant Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 46 y/o Gregory Dinsmore of Grand Island for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 <sup>rd</sup> Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. It was also discovered that Dinsmore had an outstanding warrant from the Town of Cheektowaga. Dinsmore was transferred to the custody of the Cheektowaga Police Department.
3/1	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	The complainant states she was contacted by Family Dollar employees after her wallet was found in the parking lot. When the complainant picked up the wallet she realized an unknown person(s) had stolen numerous items from inside.
3/1	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was driving around the lot of a vacant business and thought it might have something to do with drug activity. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
3/1	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident Injury	Deputies responded to a report of a motor vehicle accident where a pedestrian was struck while in the roadway. The pedestrian was transported to a local hospital with seemingly non-life threatening injuries.
3/1	South State Pkwy.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
3/2	Wallace Dr.	Customer Trouble	A cab driver stated that he was having trouble with a customer who shorted him on a fare. Prior to the arrival of Patrol the subject paid the full amount and police assistance was no longer needed.
3/2	Long Rd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a male driver was bobbing his head while driving and weaving all over the road. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
3/2	Elsie La.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that 2 white male subjects came to his door and asked for a Tom but the complainant did not know anyone with that name. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subjects by the description given.
3/3	Whitehaven Rd.	Driving While Ability Impaired by Drugs	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 19 y/o Ryan Kennedy of Grand Island for Driving While Ability Impaired by Drugs, Unlawful Possess of Marijuana (violation) and other traffic infractions. Kennedy refused to submit a sample of his blood for analysis. Kennedy was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and released to the custody of a sober 3 <sup>rd</sup> party.
3/4	Whitehaven Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.

3/4	Carter Creek Dr.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that she found several holes in her pool liner and thought they may have come from a BB Gun. Deputies were unable to determine what caused the damage.
