The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 156 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
3/1	Grand Island Blvd.	Disturbance	The complainant states that there was a fight at TC's Lounge and some of the subjects were armed with knives. Deputies spoke to numerous individuals on location and determined the complaint to be unfounded.
3/1	Grand Island Blvd.	Disturbance	The complainant states that an unknown subject punched her brother in the face while at TC's Lounge. Deputies arrived on location and found a highly intoxicated subject on the ground. Deputies spoke to numerous persons on scene and no persons offered any information that the subject was assaulted.
3/1	Grand Island Blvd.	Narcotics Arrest	While investigating the above complaint, Deputies arrested 24 y/o Jamison Crawford of Grand Island for Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7 th Degree (Class A Misdemeanor), Unlawful Possession of Marijuana (Violation) and Possession of a Controlled Substance outside of the Original Container (Violation). Crawford was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
3/1	Fix Rd.	Garage Fire	Deputies assisted Grand Island Fire Department with a report of a Garage on fire.
3/1	Stony Point Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
3/1	Whitehaven Rd.	Noise Complaint	Deputies responded to a loud noise complaint at Byblos Niagara Resort & Spa. Deputies spoke to the occupants in the room in question and advised them.
3/1	Bedell Rd.	Barking Dog	The complainant states that 2 dogs were barking in a neighboring apartment during the late hours of the night. Deputies spoke to the occupants and advised them.
3/1	White Tail Run	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that sever vehicles were playing "chicken" on the street. The vehicles left prior to the arrival of Patrol. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicles by the description given.
3/2	Whitehaven Rd.	Loud Music	Security at the Byblos Niagara Resort & Spa reported loud music coming from one of the hotel rooms during the late hours of the night. Deputies spoke to the

			occupants and advised them.
3/2	Stony Point Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
3/3	Long Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
3/4	Whitehaven Rd.	Animal Complaint	The complainant stated that a wolf was walking around near the Islewood Apartments. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
3/4	Bedell Rd	Parking Complaint	The complainant states that a vehicle was illegally parked in the handicap spot in the Country Glen Apartments. Deputies spoke to the registered owner and the vehicle was moved.
3/4	East River Rd.	Fraud	The complainant states that he was contacted by a subject claiming to be from Geek Squad. While on the phone the complainant gave the subject personal information. After the call, the complainant called Best Buy and was advised the call was most likely a scam.
3/4	East River Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.

Traffic Arrest	While investigating the above complaint, Deputies arrested 58 y/o Michael McLaughlin of Canadaigua for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 2 nd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions. McLaughlin was transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$250 bail.
3/4	Fernwood La.	Pistol Permit Investigation	Deputies conducted a background investigation of a subject who applied for a pistol permit.
3/4	East River Rd.	Residential Burglary	The complainant states that sometime in the recent day, an unknown person(s) entered his residence and while inside ripped the alarm panel off the wall. Nothing appeared to have been taken from the residence. Investigation Ongoing.
3/4	Ransom Rd.	Pistol Permit Investigation	Deputies conducted a background investigation of a subject who applied for a pistol permit.
3/5	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was hanging around a local business and was acting suspiciously. The subject left prior to the arrival of Patrol. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject by the description given.
3/5	Grand Island Blvd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle was swerving all over the road. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
3/5	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
3/5	Fix Rd.	Road Obstruction	The complainant states that a water main break was causing debris to block the roadway. Grand Island Highway Department was notified.
3/6	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked in a neighboring driveway that did not belong there. Deputies spoke to the driver who was on location to complete some repair work.
3/6	Ransom Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a pickup truck was in a driveway of a nearby abandoned residence and was

			loading things into the vehicle. Deputies spoke with the subjects who were on location performing scheduled maintenance to the home.
3/6	Grand Island Blvd.	Assist Person	The complainant states that she was at the car wash and her vehicle became stuck inside. Deputies contacted the owner of the business who responded and was able to fix the problem.
3/6	Baseline Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
3/6	South State Pkwy.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle was traveling the wrong direction on South State Parkway headed toward the Grand Island Bridge. Deputies checked the parkway but were unable to locate any vehicles traveling the wrong way.
3/7	Driftwood Ct.	Attempted Break In	The complainant states that sometime during the recent day, an unknown person(s) attempted to break into a garage door, causing damage in the process. It did not seem entry was made and nothing appeared to have been stolen.

Deputies responded to 10 Burglary False alarm calls and 7 Fire Alarms during the dates of this report.
