The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 193 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
3/5	Grand Island Blvd.	Marijuana Possession	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 20 y/o David Holler of Grand Island for Unlawful Possession of Marijuana (Violation) and a traffic infraction. Holler was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
3/5	I-190	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a vehicle was driving recklessly on the I-190 during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
3/5	Majestic Woods Dr.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) egged his house.
3/5	Staley Rd.	Warrant Arrest	Following an investigation of an unrelated complaint, Deputies arrested 38 y/o Richard Niedzwiecki of Grand Island after a check showed he had an outstanding warrant from the Town of Hamburg. Niedzwiecki was turned over to the custody of the Town of Hamburg Police Department.
3/5	West River Rd.	Hunting Complaint	The complainant states that a subject was shooting birds and was unsure if it was legal. Deputies located the subject who had the proper paperwork to hunt water fowl.
3/5	Whitehaven Rd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a vehicle traveling on Whitehaven Rd. was driving in the wrong lane and weaving all over the place. Deputies checked but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
3/6	East River Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states she observed a male subject with a flashlight on her back porch during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any persons or footprints in the snow.
3/6	West River Rd.	Shots Fired	The complainant states she heard numerous gun shots across the street from her residence. Deputies checked and determined it was hunters with proper paperwork to hunt.
3/6	Stony Point Rd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a vehicle was swerving all over the road. Deputies checked but were unable to

			locate the vehicle by the description given.
3/6	West River Pkwy.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states he found hypodermic needles in the grass while at the overlook on West River Pkwy. Deputies located the hypodermics and disposed of them.
3/6	Hennepin Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	The complainant states her vehicle was struck several days earlier while parked on the street on Hennepin Rd. The striking vehicle left no information before fleeing the scene.
3/7	Baseline Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
3/7	Stony Point Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that several youths entered a vacant house next door. Deputies checked the area and premise but found no subjects.
3/7	Baseline Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that money was reported missing from several client accounts at the Heritage Center group home. Investigation ongoing.
3/8	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
3/8	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	Employees at Bailly's Food Market state that another employee was stealing items from the business during her shift. Investigation Ongoing.
3/8	Alvin Rd.	Larceny	Employees of Fucillo Chevrolet state that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole several tires off of a vehicle on the sales lot.
3/8	East River Rd.	Animal Complaint	The complainant states that while she was walking her dog, another dog bit hers, causing an injury. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
3/8	Whitehaven Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states that a horse was running loose in the area. Deputies were able to contact the owner who retrieved the animal.
3/9	Alvin Rd.	Larceny	Employees of Fucillo Chevrolet state that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole several tires off of a vehicle on the sales lot.
3/9	Grand Island Blvd.	Drunk Driving	The complainant states that a vehicle was driving all over the road. Deputies found the vehicle in question and performed a traffic stop. Investigation revealed the driver was intoxicated. Deputies arrested 57 y/o Toh Bah of Buffalo for Driving While Intoxicated, and an additional charge of Felony Driving While Intoxicated under the Leandra's Law Statute because Bah had a child passenger in the vehicle. Bah refused to submit a sample of his breath for chemical analysis. Bah was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending his arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.
3/9	Stony Point Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
3/10	Stony Point Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states a suspicious vehicle was sitting at the end of his driveway. Deputies located the vehicle and determined the occupant was a friend of the complainant's son.
3/10	Alvin Rd.	Larceny	Employees of Fucillo Chevrolet state that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole several tires off of a vehicle on the sales lot.

3/10	Glen Avon Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Deputies located an occupied vehicle parked at the dead end of Glen Avon Rd. The occupants were advised and left without incident.
3/10	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Deputies located an occupied vehicle parked in Veterans Park during the late evening hours. The occupants were advised and left without incident.
