



Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 173 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
3/7	Wallace Dr.	Property Found	The complainant states she found a bicycle lying in the roadway. Deputies removed the bicycle and transported it back to the District 1 substation to await a possible owner to come forward.
3/7	Long Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle / Warrant Arrest	Deputies located an occupied suspicious vehicle at a closed business during the evening hours. Their investigation led to the arrest of the driver 25 y/o Lacey Moll of Niagara Falls after a check showed she had an outstanding warrant from the Niagara County Sheriff's Office. Moll was transported to the custody of Niagara County Sheriff's Office, the second occupant of the vehicle was advised and left without incident.
3/8	I-190	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle was headed northbound in the southbound lanes of the I-190 coming onto Grand Island. Deputies checked the area but did not observe any vehicles traveling in the wrong direction.
3/8	I-190	Drunk Driving	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 46 y/o Paul McCarey of Lockport for Driving While Intoxicated and other traffic infractions. McCarey registered a .15% B.A.C. after submitting a sample of his breath for chemical analysis. McCarey was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and released to the custody of a sober 3 rd party.
3/8	Whitehaven Rd.	Disorderly Person	Employees of Byblos Niagara Resort and Spa state that several guests had made complaints about the occupants in a nearby room during the late hours of the night. Deputies spoke with the occupants and determined from hotel staff that they were no longer welcome on the premise. The subjects were escorted from the property by Patrol without incident.
3/8	Pin Oak Cir.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that the surveillance footage on his property recorded a vehicle pulling into his driveway and a subject exiting the car and walking up to the complainant's garage door. It did not appear that entry was made into the residence and nothing was reported

			stolen or damaged.
3/8	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident in the parking lot of Burger King. No injuries were reported.
3/9	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime on Friday 3/6/2015 an unknown person(s) stole his bicycle from the side of Tops. Patrol determined the bicycle had been found in a nearby residential area and it was returned to the owner.
3/9	Bush Rd.	Road Obstruction	Deputies responded to a report of broken glass in the roadway causing a hazard for motorists. NITTEC was notified and responded to clean up the debris.
3/9	Regency Dr.	Warrant Arrest	While investigating an unrelated complaint, Deputies arrested 35 y/o Janelle Kaifas of Grand Island after a check showed she had an outstanding arrest warrant from the City of Lackawanna. Kaifas was transferred to the custody of the Lackawanna Police Department.
3/9	Grand Island Blvd.	Animal Complaint	The complainant states her dog was injured in a fight with another dog earlier in the day. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
3/9	I-190	Traffic Arrest / Narcotics and Warrant Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 45 y/o Douglas Corner Sr. of Kenmore for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. He was also found to be in possession of several prescription medications and was charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7 th Degree (Class A Misdemeanor). Corner also had an outstanding bench warrant from the City of Tonawanda. Corner was transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$500 bail.
3/10	Grand Island Blvd.	Customer Trouble	Employees of Wheelfind Towing state that a customer was becoming irate and causing a disturbance after she was unable to produce proof of ownership paperwork and was denied the return of her vehicle. All parties were advised.
3/10	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident in the parking lot of Tops. No injuries were reported.
3/10	West River Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states 2 dogs were running loose in the area. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
3/10	East River Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Deputies located an occupied suspicious vehicle parked in Buckhorn State Park during the late evening hours. The occupant was advised and left without incident.
3/11	Carter Dr.	Barking Dog	The complainant states that a dog was barking in the area during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked and determined the complaint was unfounded.
3/11	Waterford Park	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that while his children were playing outside they found what appeared to be drugs. Deputies took possession of the items and destroyed them.
3/12	Ransom Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	The complainant states that his vehicle was struck while it was parked in the lot of Grand Island High School.

			The suspect vehicle fled the area without leaving any information.
3/12	Fix Rd.	Identity Theft	The complainant states that an unknown person(s) used her personal information to file a tax return without her permission.
3/12	Grand Island Blvd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call at Elderwood Nursing Home. Deputies spoke with staff on location and the caller and determined the call was a misdial.
3/13	Bedell Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 36 y/o Dale Page of Cheektowaga for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor), Operating a Motor Vehicle with a suspended registration and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license and license plates were currently suspended. Page was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
3/13	West River Rd.	Narcotics Arrest	The complainant states a male subject was shooting up with heroin in a driveway of a nearby residence. Deputies investigation led to the arrest of 28 y/o Timothy Mulvey of Grand Island for Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7 th Degree (Class A Misdemeanor) and Possession of a Hypodermic Instrument (Class A Misdemeanor). Mulvey was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
3/13	Stony Point Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
3/13	Stony Point Rd.	Accident Hit & Run / Traffic Arrest	The complainant states that a vehicle drove onto his lawn and became stuck. The driver was able to free the vehicle and fled the scene. Deputies located the vehicle nearby using the description given by the complainant. Their investigation led to the arrest of 19 y/o Paul Long of Grand Island for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Long was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
